

PANDSER NAIL SEALING TAPE

GENERAL INFORMATION

Pandser Nail Sealing Tape provides a water-resistant and airtight seal when fixing battens to membranes. Thanks to its polyethylene foam composition, the tape forms a durable intermediate layer that prevents direct contact between the battens and the membrane.

This helps protect the membrane from potential damage caused by acids or chemicals released from (treated) wood. Additionally, the tape ensures a seamless seal around screw and staple holes.

The synthetic rubber adhesive layer allows for quick and easy installation.

Pandser nail sealing tape is in most cases wider than the counter batten, keeping it clear of the roof membrane. This keeps the counter batten dry and prevents water from penetrating screw or nail perforations.



APPLICATIONS

Pandser nail sealing tape is used for the waterproof sealing of roof membranes on sloping roofs underneath the battens, especially for roof slopes less than 25°.

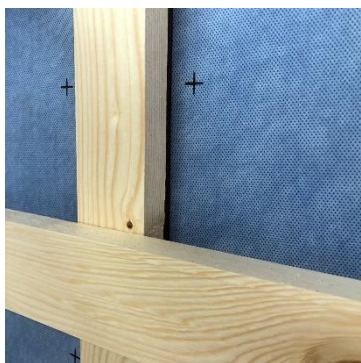
PROCESSING INSTRUCTIONS

- Ensure the surface is clean and free of dust for good adhesion.
- Do not apply the Pandser nail sealing tape to frozen surfaces, as it will not adhere properly.
- Apply the tape in vertical strips on the roof membrane.
- Then position the counter batten exactly in the middle of the tape, ensuring that the Pandser nail sealing tape remains visible on both sides underneath the counter batten.
